- The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo at 7:01 P.M.
- The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo opened the meeting with the public forum, noting that no one from the public was in attendance to address the Board of Fire Commissioners. Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo noted that if any member of the public joined the meeting in person or virtually prior to the conclusion of the meeting, they would be afforded an opportunity to address the Board of Fire Commissioners.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo moved to the first order of business, the permissive referendum for the radio equipment.

Report of Commissioners

Commissioner Maureen Bailey

- Commissioner Maureen Bailey advised that she has reviewed the January and February bank statements and found no concerns or discrepancies.
- Commissioner Maureen Bailey confirmed that the cleaning supplies were ordered and that an invoice was provided.

Commissioner Jonathan A. Lucas

- Commissioner Jonathan A. Lucas confirmed that the LOSAP transfer to National Life was completed and the month-end statement was provided to the Board and Administrative staff electronically earlier in the day. Monthly or quarterly statements are expected and will be shared.
- Commissioner Jonathan A. Lucas confirmed that the LOSAP benefit form annual reporting was being corrected in coordination with Treasurer Alexandra Graniero and Deputy Treasurer Kerry McGill. Adjustments for members who were impacted are expected to appear in the April payment.
- Commission Jonathan A. Lucas confirmed that the UTV and the trailer were added to the insurance policy. The trailer registration confirmation with DMV will need to be shared with the insurance company.

Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti

- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti noted the impact of the recent storm on the budget for snow removal performed by Joe Valvano.
- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti shared that Spring cleanup will begin, and both properties are being reviewed for planting needs and maintenance.

Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo

- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo shared that J.C Beach Electric provided emergency services for repairs to the upstairs bathroom lights and identifying the voltage issue with the siren.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo added that J.C. Beach Electric will also perform some electrical work for the Fitness Room, which was included in the permissive referendum.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo noted that J.C. Beach Electric will also need to do some electrical work to move the radio handsets in bay 1 and bay 6, to avoid water damage when washing the trucks.

Report of the Chief

- Chief Zachary Patierno provided the Department summary of activity:

General Membership / Training Updates

Chief Zachary Patierno discussed the following matters:

- PESH training was held on March 9th where 50 members attended. 2 additional members completed their sexual harassment training online. October 12th will be the next in-person opportunity for the training.
- March 2nd the FIT mask testing with AAA was conducted. Members who did not attend March 2nd will have until the end of April to have the FIT mask testing completed at AAA in White Plains to remain as interior firefighters.
- February 11th Firefighter Equipment of New York was onsite for NFPA gear inspection and repairs. Repairs were completed with many of the repairs to Velcro, snaps, and the D-ring clasps tied to the bailout rope training. The repairs were higher than expected and budget for, so additional funds will need to be requested.
- Earlier in the day, another meeting was held with the Town of Bedford and NYSERDA for discussions around the battery energy storage systems proposed in the Town of Bedford. Chief Zachary Patierno noted Chief Robert Bancroft attended the meeting and invited his comments.

- Chief Robert Bancroft shared that a NYSERDA representative spoke more on the state code and NYSERDA process. The next meeting will be held after Easter. The request for the meeting to be scheduled later in the day to accommodate schedules was proposed. There is a 6-month moratorium but it appears that the process is continuing to move forward.

Upcoming and Past Events

- Advance extrication training classroom at the Bedford Hills Firehouse on March 19th and practical training at Chappaqua Crossing on March 21st and 22nd. Hosted in partnership with Signal 73 and Castle Auto Towing. 18 Vehicles, 1 MTA bus, and 1 transportation bus will be used for the training.
- March 30th Chief Hannigan from Purchase, will be teaching a Pinned and Burning class.
- April 4th the annual boot drive is scheduled. Apparatus will be positioned on Route 172 and in front of the firehouse.
- May 1st Ham Night will be held at the Bedford Hills Fire Department meeting room.
- May 22nd will be the Bedford Hills Fire Department Annual Inspection.
- March 7th Bedford Hills Fire Department attended the Mount Kisco St. Patrick's Day parade.
- Multiple storm standbys have been done this winter.

Membership Updates

- Physicals are up to date with a few individuals being outreached who were due in January.
- Chief Zachary Patierno shared no changes in membership, noting 1 member remains on medical leave.

Other Items

- Chief Zachary Patierno advised that 3 quotes have been requested for hose testing, 2 have been received. There is a potential need to move away from Waterway due to issues with their testing equipment, scheduling challenges, and unsatisfactory hose repacking after testing. Several local departments have used Reliant Hose Testing, who is less expensive and highly recommended.
- Chief Zachary Patierno noted a change for PO 2026-0018 to be corrected to Equipment Repair vs. Air Cylinders for the budget.
- Chief Zachary Patierno advised that there would be approvals needed for the FIT Testing, repairs for Car 2032, and an additional \$280 for Firefighter Equipment of New York for the gear repair.

- Chief Zachary Patierno explained that the AED in the firehouse and on the Chiefs', apparatus have reached the end of life and require replacement. The cost to replace batteries and pads for 5 machines would be \$2000 but would require replacement in 2 years. The cost to replace the 5 machines to more modern machines, requiring battery replacement every 4 years would be \$7175.00. The First Responder kit would be attached and includes a zippered pouch with nitro gloves, a pocket CPR mask, trauma sheers, NHCL wipe and a dry towelette.

Old Business

- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti provided an update on behalf of Commissioner Dominic A. Bueti that the demolition of the building and foundation are 90% removed. During the demolition, 2 underground septic tanks were located and needed to be pumped out prior to removal. The first tank was pumped out by Vogler prior to the second tank being located. The second will be scheduled for pump out and removal. This was not in the scope of work and will be an additional expense. Additionally, permits and other fees may apply as the Board of Health will be involved. The septic tanks do not impact AAA and the ability for the demolition work to continue and is expected to be completed by the end of the week. The property will then be backfilled and leveled.
- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti noted on behalf of Commissioner Dominic A. Bueti that D.P. Wolff has some additional items open before the invoice can be processed for payment. There are some items requiring rework, closeout documents, warranties, and operational manuals pending.
- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti advised on behalf of Commissioner Dominic A. Bueti that with the snow melting a water leak in the roof was found. Wayne Fazzinga will be walking the perimeter to identify the source issue.
- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti noted that the Bedford Police Department is scheduled to move to a new digital transmission system on March 16th. The change will transition from the MTA system. There is nothing needed to prepare but it will be monitored.
- Vice-Chairperson Dominick N. Bueti expressed the need for the Commissioner to be notified regarding outside use of the firehouse. There continues to be a gap in notice from the Department. Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo noted that the application does need updating and that the process going forward will need to include the application with insurance being sent to the District Secretary to have on file.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo noted that the radio project is still open due to issues with the Zello. A new replacement unit is being provided after the initial unit failed to work properly, even after warranty repairs. The new unit is expected by March 13th and will be installed.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo explained that the DVI, which runs all the cameras, has been replaced as part of the capital project from 2025.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo advised that the Fitness Room equipment was ordered after the permissive referendum was approved in February. The equipment is scheduled to arrive in about a

month. The streaming and new technology equipment will ship to WSG for their configuration and installation.

- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo explained that 6-7 fire departments were outreached for the old Peloton machine and none that were interested. Outreach to the school district will be done next.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo noted the prior update on the siren and the need for emergency repairs that are underway.
- Chairperson Joseph J. Lombardo shared that the UTV graphics are complete and that the lighting will be done next. The UTV will be parked in the rear of Bay 1 and Bay 2. The total spent is \$106,668.38 with total budget of \$125,000.00 allocated.
